Course Overview

This course provides a familiarisation with the roles and responsibilities of the EOC Logistics function and provides an opportunity to perform the processes involved within the function. On completion of this course participants will be able to:

- Develop a comprehensive logistics plan
- Co-ordinate resources within their organisation
- Describe the roles and responsibilities of logistic staff
- Describe the delivery of supplies and materials
- Discuss the use of facilities, including security measures, life support systems, supplier, materials and services needed for EOC staff to accomplish their responsibilities
- Understand the financial requirements of an EOC during an emergency

The following topics are covered:

- Introduction to logistics
- Roles and responsibilities of logistic staff
- Developing a logistics plan
- Reports and records
- Managing donations
- Developing sub-plans (i.e. tele-communication and transportation)
- Finance tracking during an emergency
